Make a Payment

You may make payments at any time while you are still in school to reduce any interest that may accrue, but you are required to begin repaying when your loans leave their grace period and/or enter repayment.

Federal student loan borrowers typically go through three stages:



In School: When you're enrolled in school at least half-time.



In Grace: The six-month period after you graduate, withdraw, or drop below half-time status.



In Repayment: When you are required to make payments on your loan.

Simple ways to pay:



Log in to your Nelnet.com account.



Download Nelnet's Loan Assist app for iPhone or Android.



Sign up for KwikPay® (auto-debit), Nelnet's automated payment system.



Mail a payment to the address on your statement.
